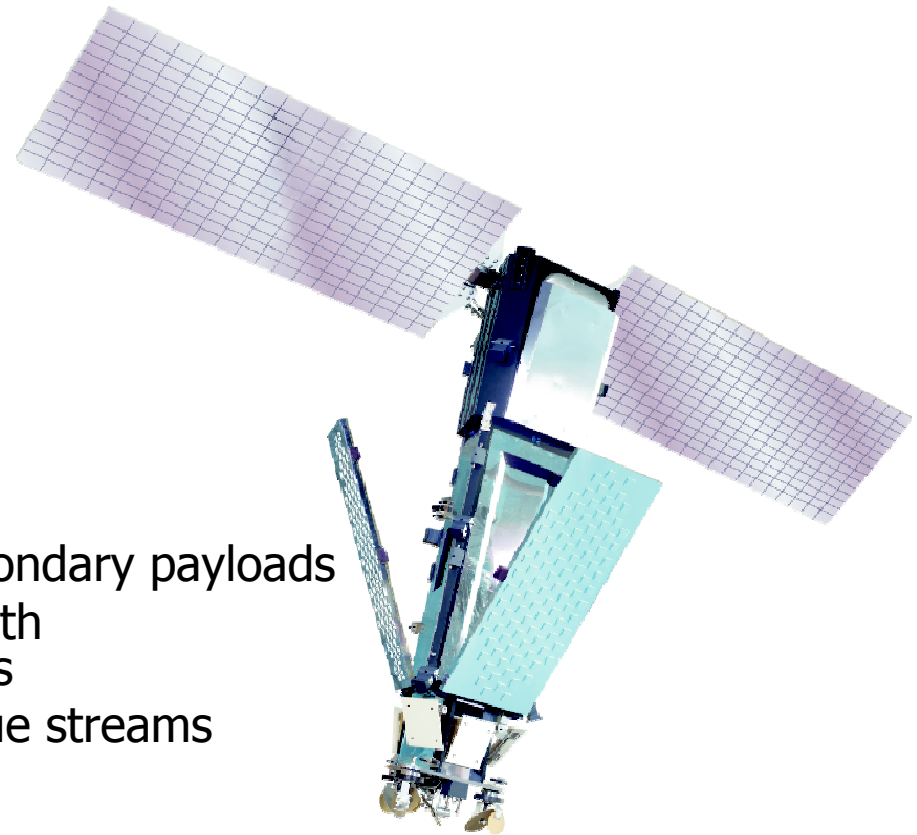

Short Burst Data unleashed the power of the constellation to allow small devices to transmit tracking and monitoring information real time from any spot on the planet.



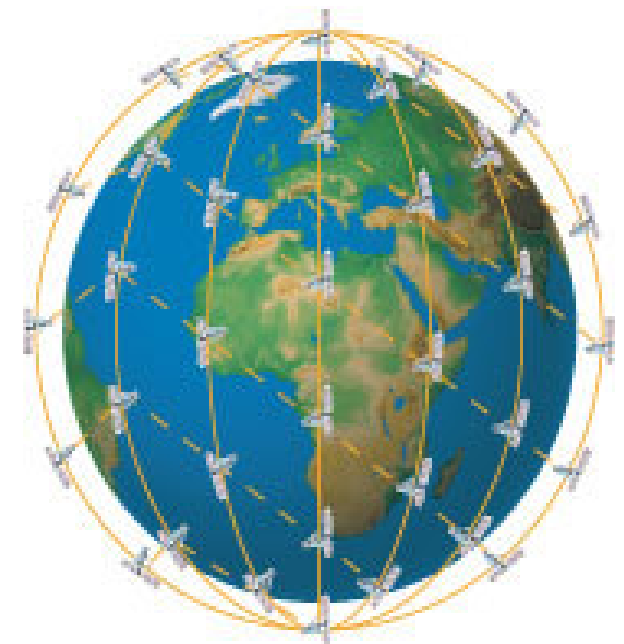
